Comfort Quilt – 195.5 cm by 195.5 cm

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## Fabric Requirements

	<b>Full</b>	<b>Twin</b>	<b>Comfort</b>
5" squares from Charm Packs or yardage	64 squares  or 1 ¼ yard	48 squares  or 1 yard	36 squares  or ¾ yard
Background Fabric	7 yards	5 ¾ yards	4 ½ yards
Accent Fabric	2 yards	1 ½ yards	1 ¼ yards







**I will be making all of my 5" squares from my Water Lily fabric.**






**My background will be scrappy neutrals. My accent will be scrappy green batiks.**

**METRIC – assuming a 108 cm (42") wide bolt. Amounts are generous, not exact.**






**Step #1: Make the Following Units**



	<b>Comfort</b>	<b>Twin</b>	<b>Full</b>
<p><b>A. 9-Patch - 3.5" square</b></p> 	(64)	(80)	(100)
<p><b>B. 4-Patch - 2.5" square</b></p> 	(64)	(80)	(100)
<p><b>C. Pairs - 1.5" by 2.5" rectangles</b></p> 	(48)	(62)	(80)
<p><b>D. Remaining 1.5" squares for use later</b></p> 	(25)	(32)	(40)

**Step #2: Make the following Units.**

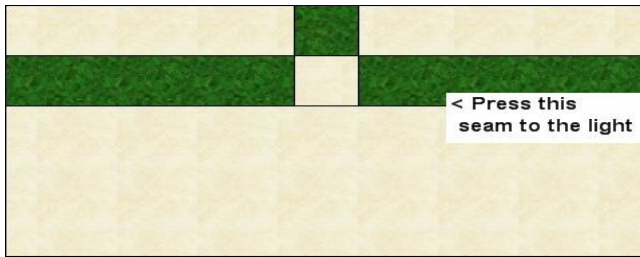
	<b>Comfort</b>	<b>Twin</b>	<b>Full</b>
<p><b>A. (2) 5" charms and (1) 1.5" by 5" background rectangle</b> <i>Press to the charms</i></p> 	(18)	(24)	(32)

<p><b>B. (2) 1.5" by 5" background rectangles and (1) 1.5" accent square</b>  <i>Press to the center square</i></p> 	(9)	(12)	(16)
<p><b>C. This Unit measures 10.5" (2) Unit A and (2) Unit B</b>  <i>Press to Unit A</i></p> 	(9)	(12)	(16)

**Step #3: Finished Unit measures 2.5" by 10.5"**

	Comfort	Twin	Full
<p><b>A. 1.5" by 5" background rectangle and 1.5" by 5" accent rectangle</b>  <i>Press to the dark</i></p> 	(96 )	(124)	(160)
<p><b>B. (2) 2.5" by 5" Units from Step A and (1) Square pair from Step #1C.</b>  <i>Press to the rectangles</i></p> 	(48)	(62)	(80)

**Step #4 : Press to the LIGHT**  
 Units should measure 5.5" by 10.5".





	Comfort	Twin	Full
Sew Step #3 to a 3.5" by 10.5" rectangle of background fabric.	(48)	(62)	(80)

**Step #5: Finished units should measure 3.5" by 5.5".**

**VERY IMPORTANT**

**Make sure upper right corner is a background fabric square.**

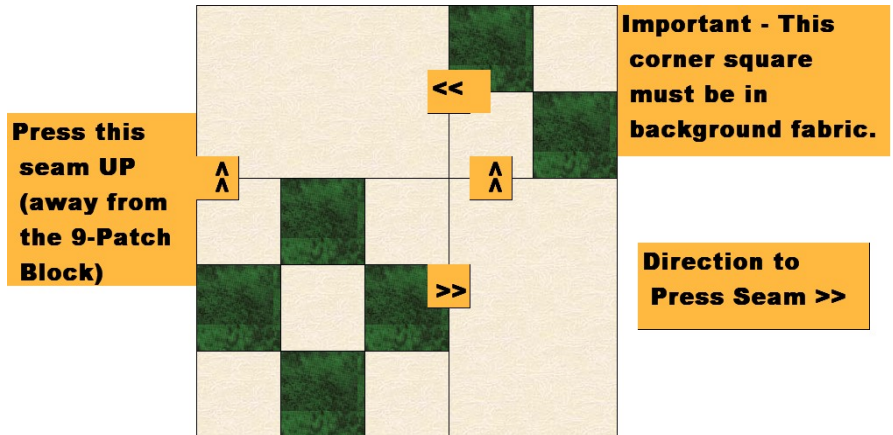
	Comfort	Twin	Full
<p><b>5A. 3.5" 9-Patch and 2.5" by 3.5" rectangle.</b>  <i>Press to the rectangle</i></p> 	(64 )	(80)	(100)
<p><b>5B. 2.5" 4-Patch and 2.5" by 3.5" rectangle</b>  <i>Press to the rectangle</i></p> 	(64 )	(80)	(100)

**Step #6: Finished units should measure 5.5" square**

**Important: Orient block so it looks like the picture.**

**DOUBLE CHECK:**

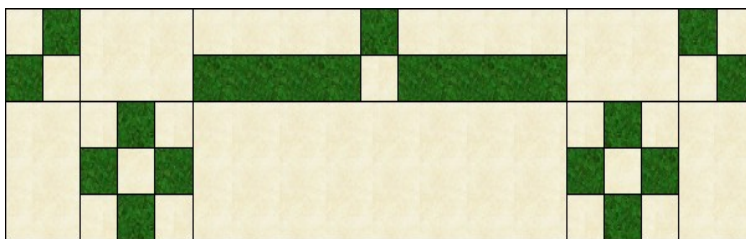
- > Is the upper right hand corner in background fabric?
- > Are seams pressed AWAY from the 9-Patch block?



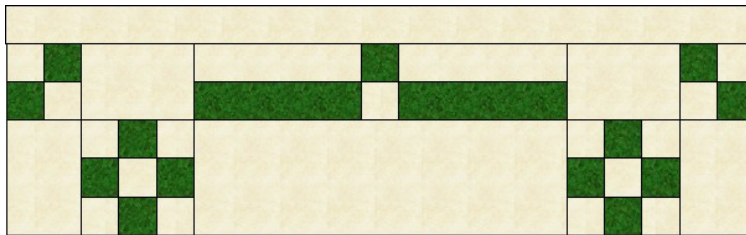
	Comfort	Twin	Full
Sew units from Step #5 together according to picture.	(64 )	(80)	(100)

**Step #7: Join units from Step #4 and Step #6.**

	Comfort	Twin	Full
7A. Sew (2) from Step #6 and (1) from Step #4 nesting seams.  Press to Step #6 rectangle. <b>Finished units should measure 5.5" by 20.5"</b> <b>Press to the Center Rectangle (Step #4).</b>	(64 )	(80)	(100)

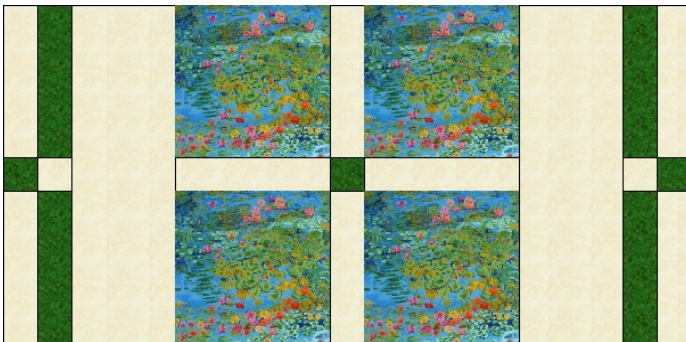


	Comfort	Twin	Full
<p><b>7B. Sew a 1.5" by 20.5" rectangle to Unit A.</b></p> <p><b>Make sure it is sewn next to the 4-patches.</b></p> <p><b>Press to the rectangles.</b></p>	(6)	(8)	(8)



**Step #8: Join units from Step #2C and Step #4.**

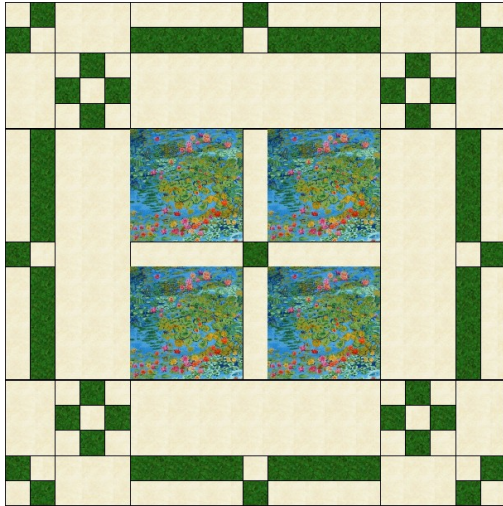
**Finished units should measure 10.5" by 20.5"**  
**Press to the outside units.**



	Comfort	Twin	Full
<p><b>8A. (2) from Step #4 and (1) from Step #2C</b></p> <p><b>Nest seams.</b>  <b>Press to Step #4 rectangle.</b></p>	(9)	(12)	(16)

**Step #8B: Sew Units from Step 7A and Step 8A.  
Finished units should measure 20.5" square.**

**IMPORTANT – MAKE SURE THE 4-Patches are in the OUTSIDE CORNERS**



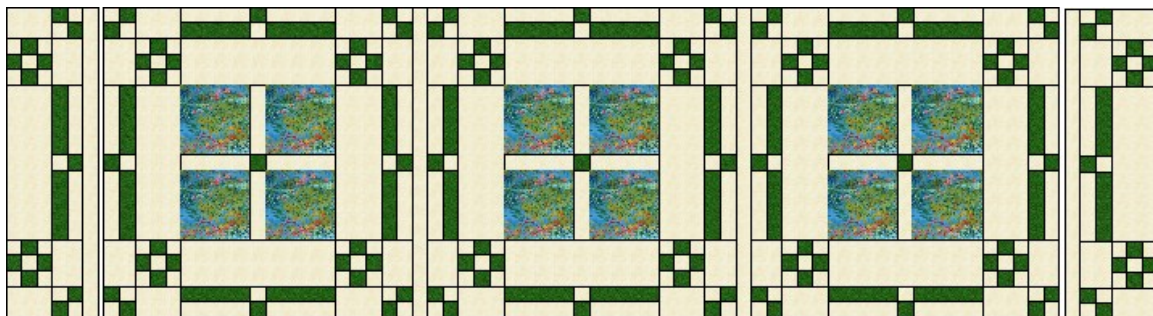
	Comfort	Twin	Full
<b>8B: (2) from Step #7A and (1) from Step #8A</b> <b>Nest seams.</b> <b>Press to Step #7A</b>	(9)	(12)	(16)

**Step #9.**

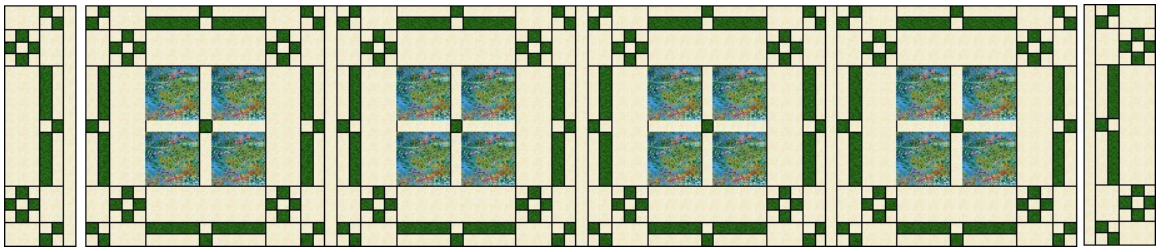
**Sew your rows – Sew a 1.5" by 20.5" sashing strip between blocks.  
Sew a Step 7A block to the end of each row.**

**Comfort and Twin Quilts**

**Rows Measure 20.5" by 74.5".**



**Full Quilt Rows**  
Measure 20.5" by 95.5".



**Add Horizontal Sashing Strips.**

- (2) per strip.      5.5" by 1.5" background strip on each end.
- (4) per strip.      1.5" square corners stones of accent fabric.
- (3) per strip.      1.5" by 20.5" background strips.

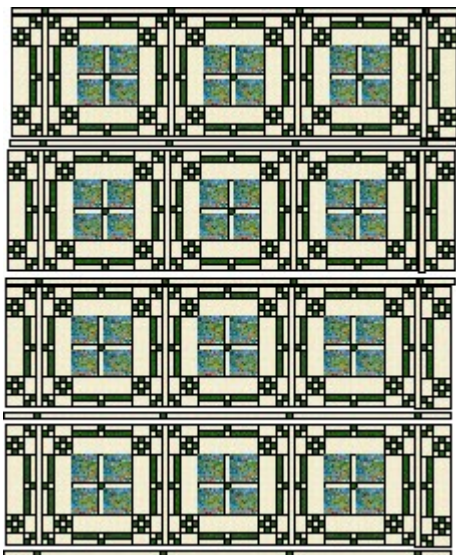
**Comfort Quilt – Make (4)**  
**Twin Quilt – Make (5)**



**Full Quilt – Make (5)**



- (2) per strip.      5.5" by 1.5" background strip on each end.
- (5) per strip.      1.5" square corners stones of accent fabric.
- (4) per strip.      1.5" by 20.5" background strips.



**Step #10: Make Top and Bottom Borders.**

**Make sure the 9-Patch blocks are in the upper outside corner.**

**For the Comfort Quilt – Make (2) of this unit**

**For the Twin Quilt – Make (2) of this unit**

**(4) per border      5.5” by 1.5” background strips**

**(3) per border      Clue #7A**

**(2) per border      Clue #6**

**Press to the background strips.**



**For the Full Quilt – Make (2) of this unit**

**(5) per border      5.5” by 1.5” background strips o**

**(4) per border      Clue #7A**

**(2) per border      Clue #6**

**Press to the background strips.**



**Sew borders to the top and bottom of your quilt. Press to the sashing strips.**
