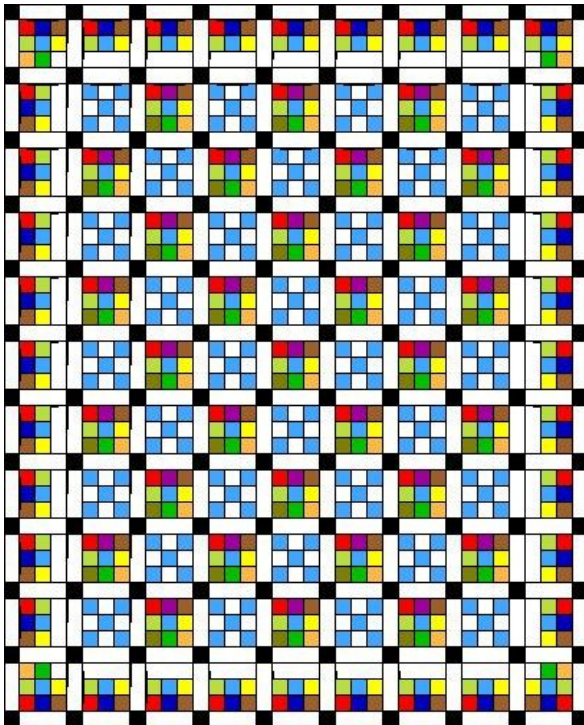
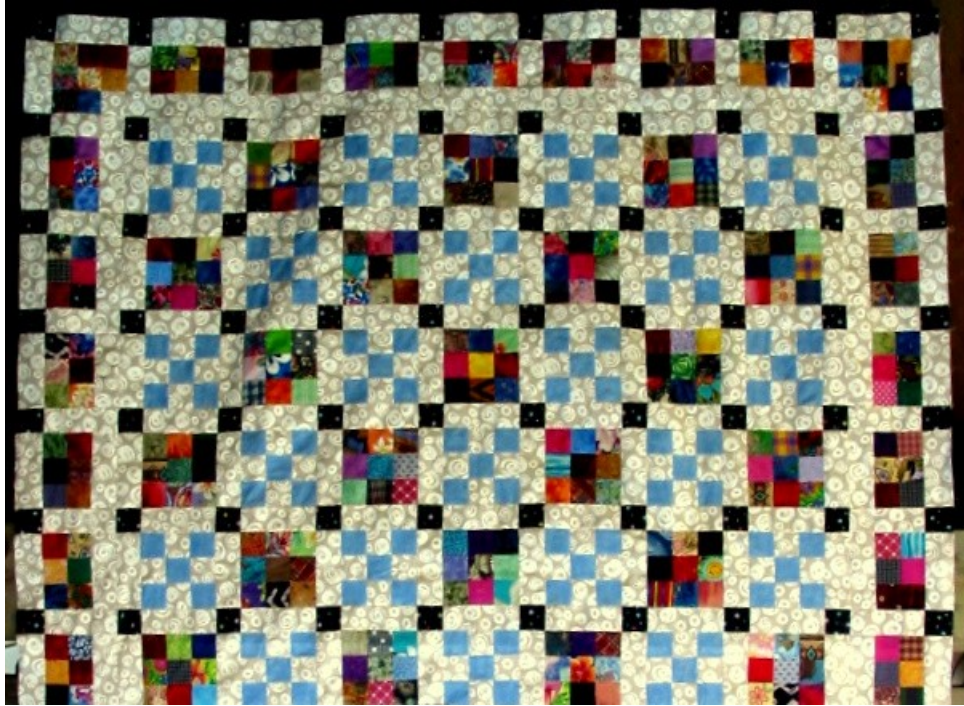

Fabric Requirements

White – 3.5 yards

Blue - $\frac{3}{4}$ yards

Black – $\frac{5}{8}$ yards

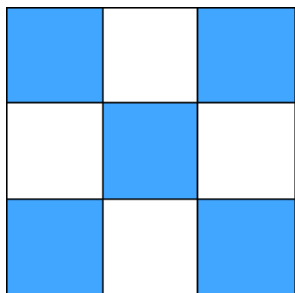
(503) scrappy 2.5” squares - 2 $\frac{1}{8}$ yards

Cutting Directions

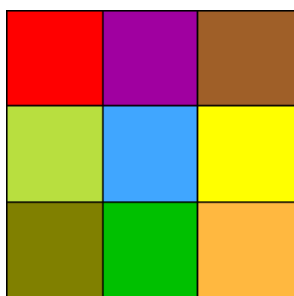
	2.5” by WOF Strips	Then cut 2.5” squares	6.5” by WOF Strips	Then cut 6.5” by 2.5” rectangles
White	8	132	15	250
Blue	10	160		
Black	8	120		

Blocks – Sew (3) rows for each block. Sew the rows together nesting seams.
Press. The direction you press the seams is not important.

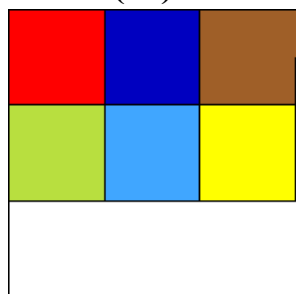
1. Make (32) – 6.5”



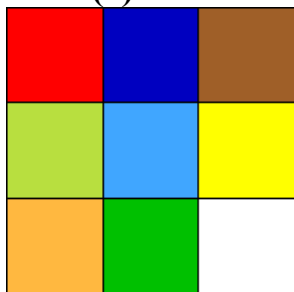
2. Make (31) – 6.5”



3. Make (32) – 6.5”



4. Make (4) – 6.5”



Rows

1. Make (2) – Top and Bottom Rows (9 blocks per row)

Order of the blocks 4-3-3-3-3-3-3-4

Notice the correct placement of the one white square in Block 4.

Alternate blocks with 6.5" by 2.5" white rectangles

Press to the rectangles.



2. Make (5) – Middle Rows (9 blocks per row)

Order of the blocks 3-1-2-1-2-1-2-1-3

(Block 4 faces sideways with white rectangle facing the center of the row.)

Alternate blocks with 6.5" by 2.5" rectangles

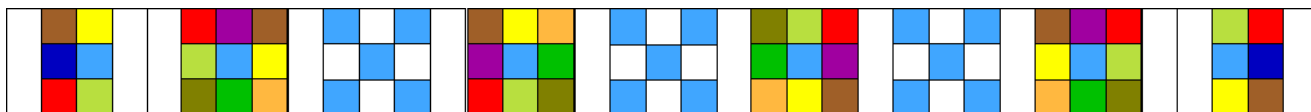


3. Make (4) – Alternate Middle Rows (9 blocks per row)

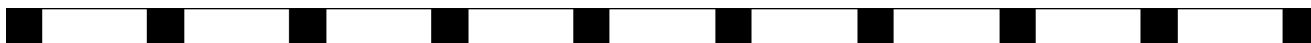
Order of the blocks 3-2-1-2-1-2-1-2-3

(Block 4 faces sideways with white rectangle facing the center of the row.)

Alternate blocks with 6.5" by 2.5" rectangles



4. Make (12) Sashing Strip rows – There are (9) 6.5" by 2.5" rectangles and (10) 2.5" black squares. **Important: Press to the white rectangles.**





Assemble Rows according to Diagram.

Press to the sashing strips.

Because you previously pressed to the white rectangles the seams should nest when you sew your rows together.
