

**Spring Mystery 2011
with 13.5” Blocks
Fabric Requirements**

I am very excited about this mystery.

I have been having so much fun with it that I have already made three quilt tops using the pattern and have plans for a couple more.

Using a 13.5” block.. this quilt is being presented in (3) sizes.

This is an excellent quilt for Charm Packs, Fat Quarters and Fat Eighths. I just finished a totally scrappy twin top using Charm Packs and love it. I supplemented with some additional fabric from my stash.

Full/Queen – 99” by 99”

Twin – 72” by 99”

Baby or Lap Quilt – 45” by 45”

Fabric Options:

Scrappy

Totally Scrappy – great for use with Charm Packs.

Good with Fat Quarters, Fat Eighths, and other larger scraps.

Or Each fabric in two or more blocks in the quilt.

Or Every block in a different fabric.

Non-Scrappy – use coordinating fabrics

You can use solids

or prints .. anything that is recognizable in a 5” square or smaller.

One light fabric

One medium fabric

One dark fabric

1. Totally Scrappy (I supplemented my Charm Packs with 5” squares cut from fabrics in my stash.)

	Baby/Lap	Twin	Full/Queen
5” squares or charms	37	155	221
Background Fabric	1 ¼ yd	4 yards	5 ½ yards

2. Scrappy with each block in a different fabric.

	Baby/Lap	Twin	Full/Queen
Number of different fabrics	9	35	49
5” squares per fabric	5 squares from (1) fabric 4 squares from (8) fabrics	5 squares from (1) fabric 4 squares from (8) fabrics	5 squares from (1) fabric 4 squares from (8) fabrics
Background Fabric	1 ¼ yd	4 yards	5 ½ yards

3. Scrappy with 2 or more blocks in each fabric.

(Not recommended for the baby quilt size.)

The Twin has 35 blocks and the Full/Queen has 49 blocks.

You can get (3) blocks from (1) 12” (1/3 yard) by width of fabric cut.

	Blocks to make in each Fabric	Quantity per Fabric	Twin	Full/Queen
Blocks to make in each Fabric	3	1/3 yard	12 different fabrics	17 different fabrics
OR Blocks to make in each Fabric	6	2/3 yard	6 different fabrics	9 different fabrics
Background Fabric			4 yards	5 ½ yards

4. Non-Scrappy

	Baby/Lap	Twin	Full/Queen
Dark Fabric	½ yard	1 ¼ yards	1 ¾ yards
Medium Fabric	½ yard	1 ¼ yards	1 ¾ yards
Background Fabric	1 ¼ yards	4 yards	5 ½ yards
