

# Spring Mystery 2011 with 13.5” Blocks Clue #4

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Which fabric should I use?

1. All scrappy quilt – each COLORED square can be a separate fabric. **OR**
2. Each block a different fabric. **OR**
3. Two colored fabrics in the quilt.

**Decide which of your fabrics is Fabric #1 and which is Fabric #2. OR**

4. Make more than one block with a fabric.  
Use Table below to help choose the fabrics for Block #2. These are only suggestions.  
Feel free to make any changes based on your own fabric inventory.

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	<b>Blocks in the quilt</b>	<b>Number of #4 Blocks</b>	<b>Number of Different Fabrics in the quilt</b>	<b>Recommendation for Block #4</b> <i>You will be repeating fabrics used in the previous clues.</i>
<b>Baby Quilt</b>	9	4	9	Each block in a different fabric.
<b>Twin Quilt</b>	35	10	Between 8 and 16	1-2 of Block #4 in the same fabric
<b>Full/Queen Quilt</b>	49	12	Between 8 and 15	2-3 of Block #4 in the same fabric

## Block #4 13.5” finished (14” unfinished)

**Baby Quilt – Make (4)**  
**Twin Quilt – Make (10)**  
**Full Quilt – Make (12)**

### Choose your fabrics:

Options #1 and #2 are obvious.

If you are using Fabric Option #3 above use **Fabric #2**.

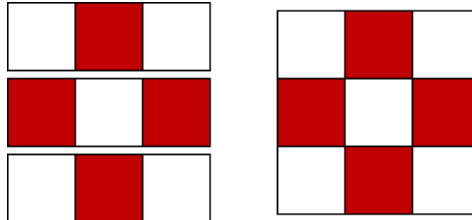
If you are using Fabric Option #4 use the table above to help select fabrics.

**Unit 1.** (4) colored 2” squares

(5) white 2” squares

Sew (3) rows according to the diagram. Press to the white squares.

Press rows seams to top and bottom rows.



Sew the rows together pressing to the top and bottom rows.

**IMPORTANT:** *Make sure this unit measures 5”.*

*Please measure after sewing to make sure. The squares are small and it is easy to make the seam allowance too big.*

**Unit 2.** (1) 9-patch from Unit 1 above

(2) 5” white squares

(3) 5” colored squares

(1) 5” by 13.5” white rectangle

**Sew in rows according to diagram.**

**IMPORTANT Pressing Directions:**

**Sew rows according to diagram.**

*Press to the white squares in the top row.*

*Press to the 9-Patch in the center row.*

**Sew rows together.**

*Press to the outside rows.*
