

Jelly Roll Mystery Clue #1

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Step 1:

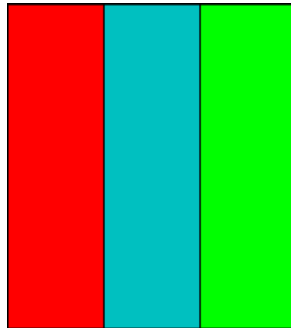
Gather up all your 2.5" by 10.5" rectangles cut from your Jelly Roll fabric.

Sew (3) rectangles of different fabrics together. *Press to the inside.*

Large Quilt – make (24) of these units.

Medium Quilt – make (17).

Small Quilt – make (12).



Step 2;

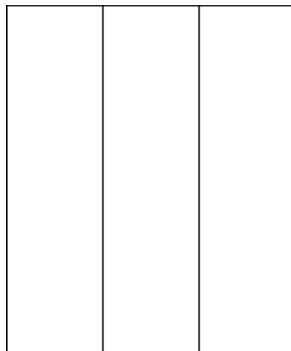
Gather up all your 2.5" by 10.5" rectangles cut from your background fabric.

Sew (3) rectangles together. *Press to the outside.*

Large Quilt – make (25) of these units.

Medium Quilt – make (18).

Small Quilt – make (13).



Jelly Roll Mystery Clue #2

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Step 1:

Gather up all your 2.5" by 6.5" rectangles cut from your Jelly Roll Fabric.

Gather up 2.5" squares from your Background fabric.

Large quilt (96 squares). Medium Quilt (68 squares). Small Quilt (48 squares).

Sew a 2.5" square to either end of each 2.5" by 6.5" rectangle.

Press to the Jelly Roll fabric. The finished units will measure 2.5" by 10.5".

Large quilt (48 units). Medium Quilt (34 units). Small Quilt (24 units).



Step 2:

Gather up all your 2.5" by 6.5" rectangles cut from your Background fabric.

Gather up 2.5" squares from your Jelly Roll Fabric.

Large quilt (100 squares). Medium Quilt (72 squares). Small Quilt (52 squares).

Sew a 2.5" square to either end of each 2.5" by 6.5" rectangle.

Press to the Jelly Roll fabric. The finished units will measure 2.5" by 10.5".

Large quilt (50 units). Medium Quilt (36 units). Small Quilt (26 units).



Jelly Roll Mystery Clue #3

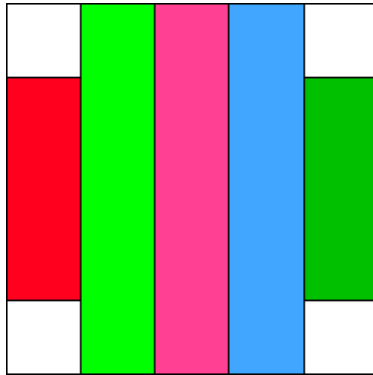
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Block #1 – The Jelly Roll Blocks:

Gather up all your units from **(Clue #1 – Step 1)** and **(Clue #2 – Step 1)**.
Sew a Clue #2 unit to either side of each Clue #1 unit.

Press to the outside.

Square up to 10.5” square.

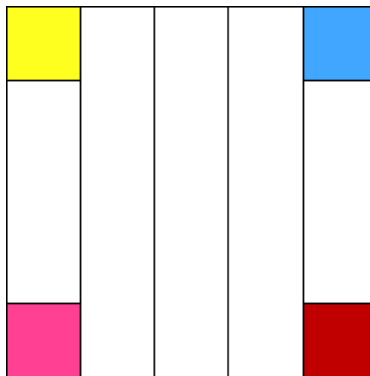


Block #2 – The Background Fabric Blocks:

Gather up all your units from **(Clue #1 – Step 2)** and **(Clue #2 – Step 2)**.
Sew a Clue #2 unit to either side of each Clue #1 unit.

Press to the inside.

Square up to 10.5” square.



Jelly Roll Mystery Clue #4

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Borders:

Sew rows of alternating 2.5" squares from your Jelly Roll fabric and Background fabric.

Press squares towards the Jelly Roll fabric.

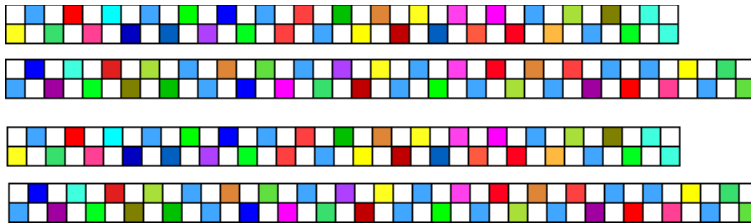
Sew 2 rows together nesting seams.

Press this long seam toward the row with a Jelly Roll square at each end.

Large Quilt:

4 rows with 35 squares in each row. (2) rows have Jelly Roll fabrics at each end and
(2) rows have Background fabric at each end.

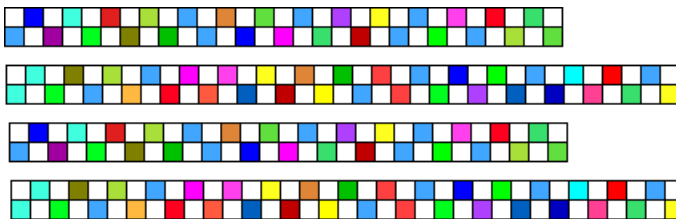
4 rows with 39 squares in each row. (2) rows have Jelly Roll fabrics at each end and
(2) rows have Background fabrics at each end.



Medium Quilt:

4 rows with 29 squares in each row. (2) rows have Jelly Roll fabrics at each end and
(3) rows have Background fabric at each end.

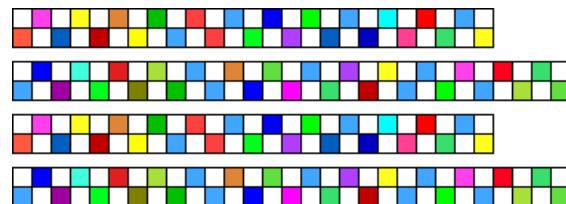
4 rows with 35 squares in each row. (2) rows have Jelly Roll fabrics at each end and
(2) rows have Background fabrics at each end.



Small Quilt:

4 rows with 25 squares in each row. (2) rows have Jelly Roll fabrics at each end and
(4) rows have Background fabric at each end.

4 rows with 29 squares in each row. (2) rows have Jelly Roll fabrics at each end and
(2) rows have Background fabrics at each end.



Jelly Roll Mystery Clue #6

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The Mystery is Solved

Final Assembly:

Sew the rows of blocks together nesting seams.

Sew the side borders to the quilt.

(The Jelly Roll squares are in the outside corners.)

Press to the border.

Sew the top and bottom borders to the quilt.

(The Jelly Roll squares are in the outside corners.)

Press to the border.
