12 Block Quilt

Available size – Comfort Quilt – 61” by 77”, all blocks are 13” (13.5” unfinished)

20 Block Quilt

Available size - Twin – 77” by 93”, all blocks are 13” (13.5” unfinished)



Option B with Pieced Borders:

12 Block Quilt

Available size – Comfort Quilt – 59” by 74”, all blocks are 13” (13.5” unfinished)

20 Block Quilt

Available size - Twin – 74” by 89”, all blocks are 13” (13.5” unfinished)

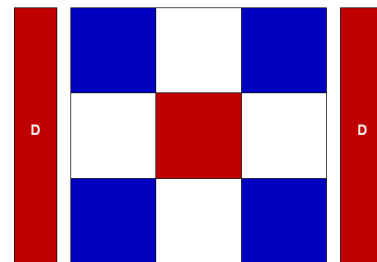
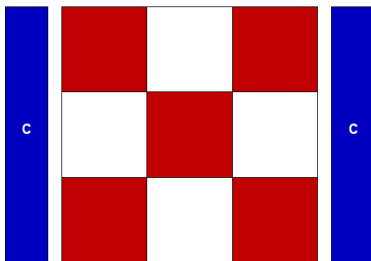
1. Sew squares into rows.

Press in either direction.



3. Sew side strips to nine patch.
Press to the strips.

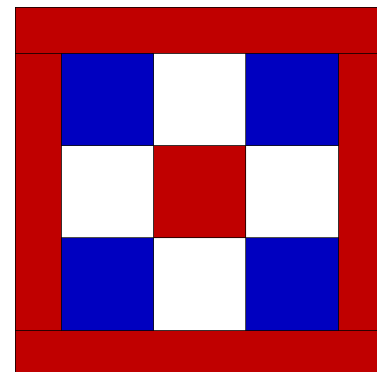
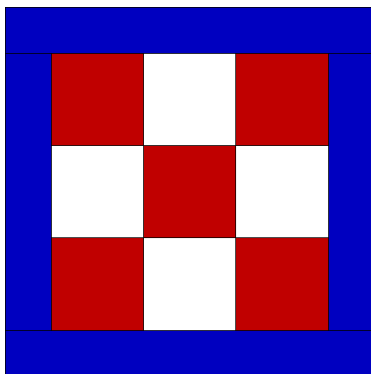


4. Sew top and bottom strips to nine patch.
Press to the strips.

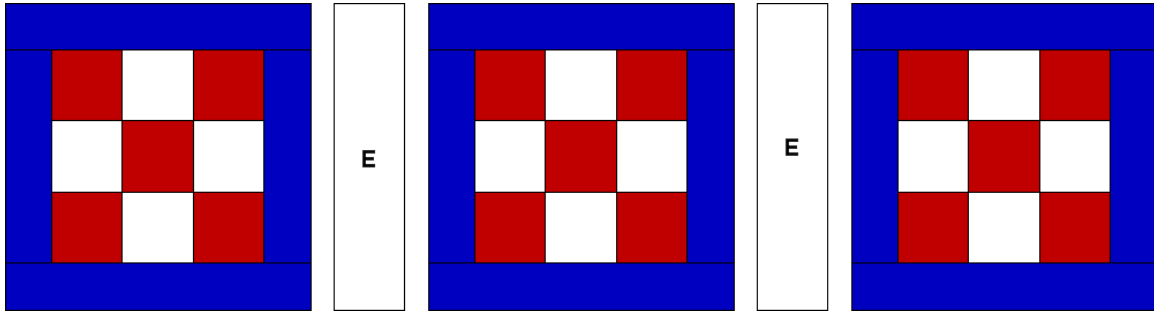

Final Quilt Assembly
Option A

12 Block Quilt

- 1. Make (4) block rows.**
Press to the sashing strips.

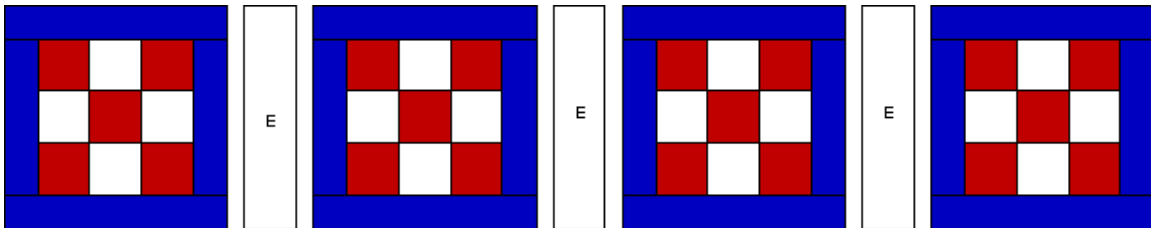


- 2. Make (3) sashing rows.**
Press to the sashing strips.



20 Block Quilt

- 1. Make (5) block rows.**
Press to the sashing strips.



- 2. Make (4) sashing rows.**
Press to the sashing strips.

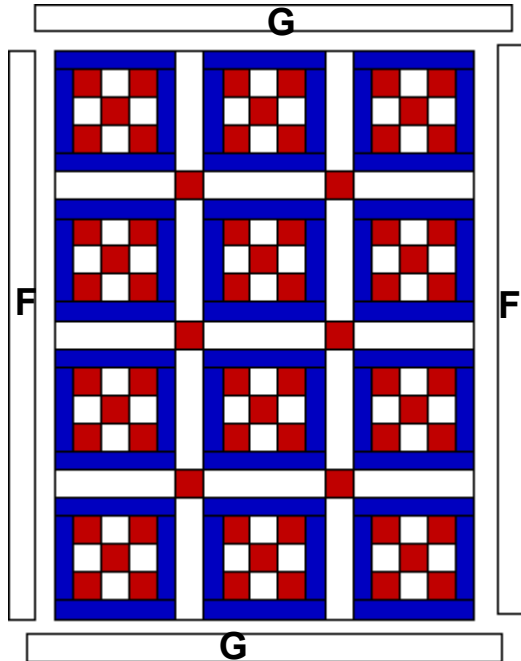


Final Quilt Assembly (cont.)

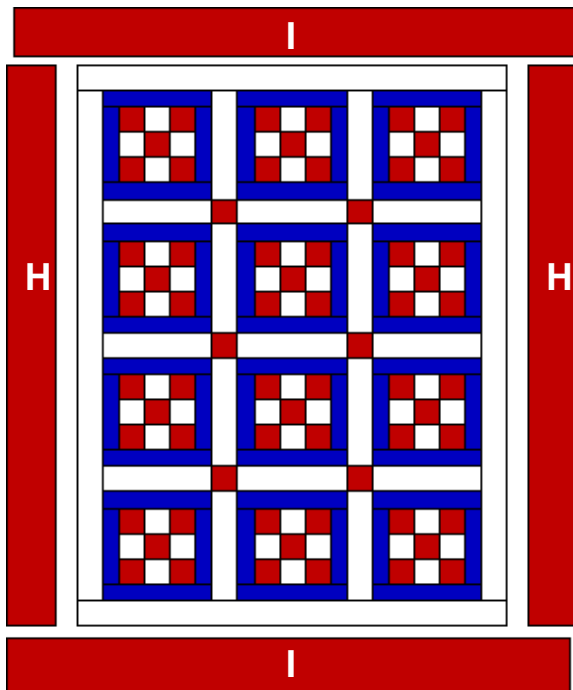
Option A

12 Block and 20 Block Quilts:

1. Sew your block and sashing rows together. Press to sashing.
2. Sew the inside border to the blocks and sashing. Press to border.



3. Sew the outside border. Press to border.



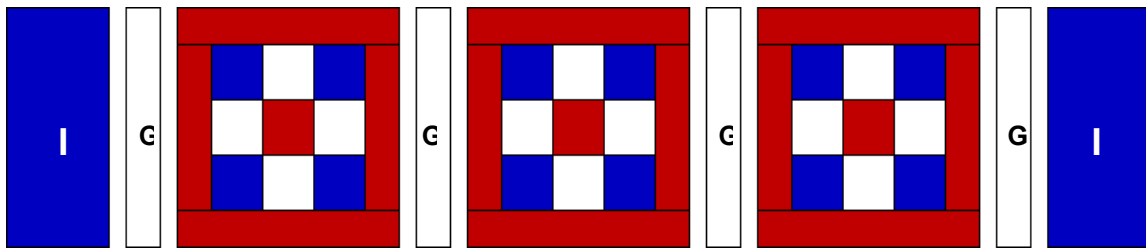
Final Quilt Assembly Option B

12 Block Quilt

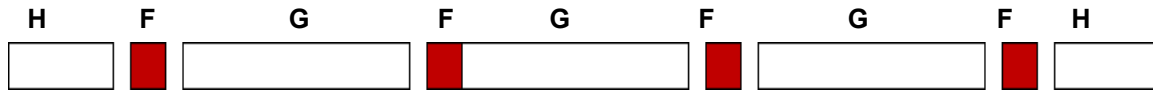
1. **Make (2) – The first and last rows.**
Press to the white.



2. **Block Rows – make (4)**
Press to the white.



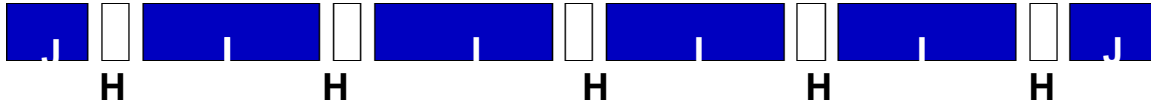
3. **Sashing Rows – make (5)**
Press to the white.



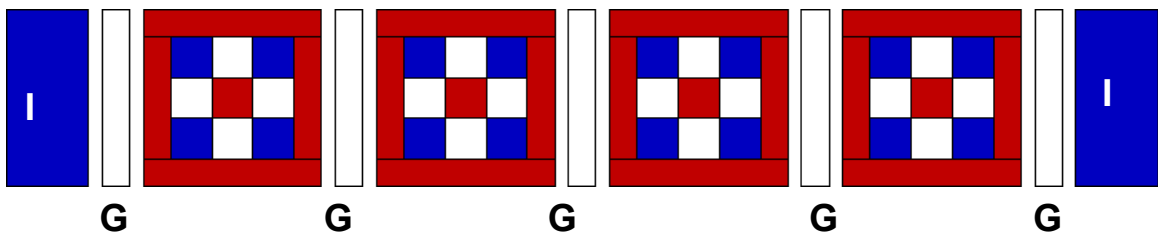
Final Quilt Assembly Option B

20 Block Quilt

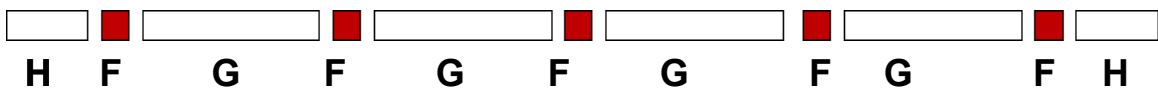
1. **Make (2) – The first and last rows.**
Press to the white.



2. **Block Rows – make (5)**
Press to the white.

**Final Quilt Assembly (cont.)
Option A**

12 Block and 20 Block Quilts:

Sew your block rows, sashing rows and top and bottom rows together.

Press to sashing rows.
