


Delectable Stars

Blocks - 18.5" unfinished -



Tools Needed - Quilting rulers, rotary cutter, mat and quarter inch foot

Cut (4) 6.5" squares background fabric for each block.

Cut (4) 9" squares background fabric for each block.

Cut (4) 9" squares colored fabrics for each block.

Make Half Square triangles from the 9" squares.

Draw a diagonal line through the back of each colored fabric.


Put each colored square together with one background square (right sides together) and sew 1/4" on either side of the drawn line.

Cut on the drawn line.

Press to the background fabric.

You will have (8) half square triangles for each block.


The more different colors used for the half square triangles the scrappier your blocks will be.




Square up your half square triangles to 8" square.

Place your half square triangles in two piles and orient each pile according to the picture above.


Cut each half square triangle into (4) 2" by 8" rectangles.




Organize the cut rectangles.




1. Sew (4) for each block.
Sew the rectangles together. Square up to 6.5" according to the picture.






2. Sew and cut (4) for each block.



3. Sew the squares from above into the center of the star. Nest seams.



3. Assemble Block.
