Comfort Quilt – 60” by 74” (153cm by 188cm)

Twin Quilt – 74” by 88” (188cm by 224cm)

Full Quilt – 88” by 88” (224cm by 224cm)

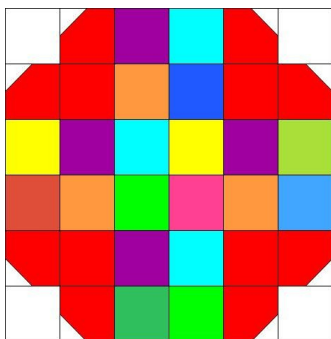

### Quilt using Option A Blocks:

This is the Option A Block (12 in. Block, 12.5" unfinished)

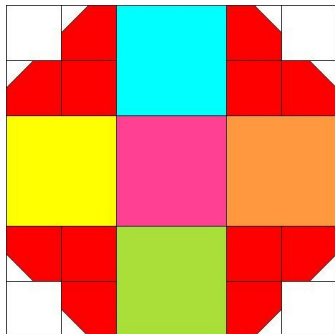

Comfort Quilt – 12 Blocks	1 3/4 yards	2 3/4 yards	296
Twin Quilt – 20 Blocks	2 yards	3 3/8 yards	472
Full Quilt – 25 Blocks	2 1/4 yards	4 yards	580

### Quilt using Option B Blocks:

This is the Option B Block (12 in. Block, 12.5" unfinished)



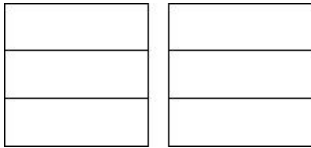

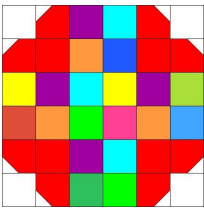
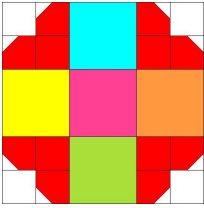
It has detailed directions on sewing each block.

**Make these subunits. Sewing directions are part of the Scrap Happy Block Pattern. They are easier and faster to make if you do chain sewing.**

## Border Blocks

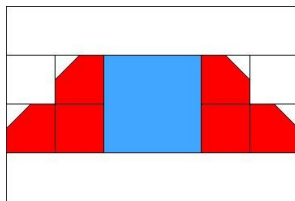
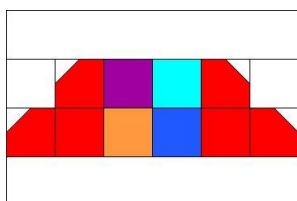
Make these units from your already constructed subunits.

<b>Option A</b> 4.5" by 12.5"		8	14	18	20

**Sew a 2.5" by 12.5" rectangle to either side of your border blocks.**

Press to the rectangles.

Units measure 8.5" by 12.5"

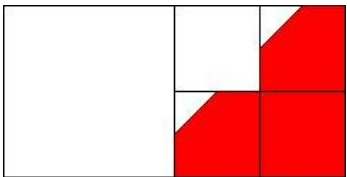
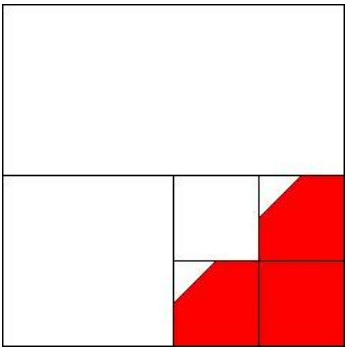


## Corner Blocks– Make (4)

### (1) Heart subunit

(1) 4.5" white square

(1) 4.5" by 8.5" white rectangle

1. Sew 4.5" square to your heart. Make sure you are orienting the heart correctly. Press to the square.	
2. Sew 8.5" rectangle to the top of your unit from above. Press to the rectangle.	



**Sashing Rows – Using 2.5” by 12.5” white rectangles, 2.5” by 6.5” white rectangles and 2.5” red squares.**

**Vertical Sashing strips in the top and bottom borders.**

	Baby	Comfort	Twin	Full
Sew 2.5” red square to 6.5” white rectangle. Press to the rectangle.	6	8	10	12



**Horizontal Sashing strips between rows.**

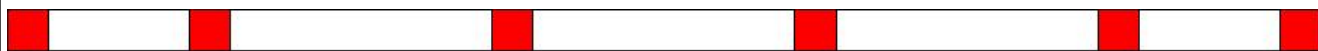
**Press to the white fabric.**

**These units use 2.5” by 12.5” white rectangles, 2.5” by 6.5” white rectangles and 2.5” red squares.**

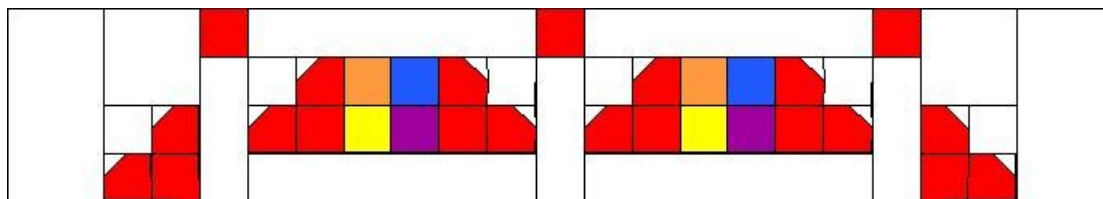

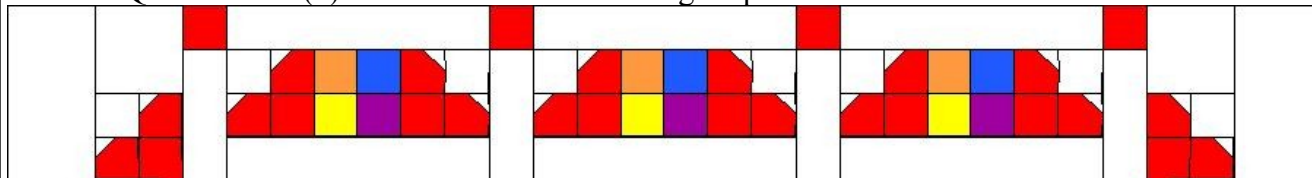
**Sew TOP and Bottom Rows of the Quilt according to diagram**

**Corner heart on each end, and a 6.5” white rectangle with 2.5” red square unit between border blocks.**

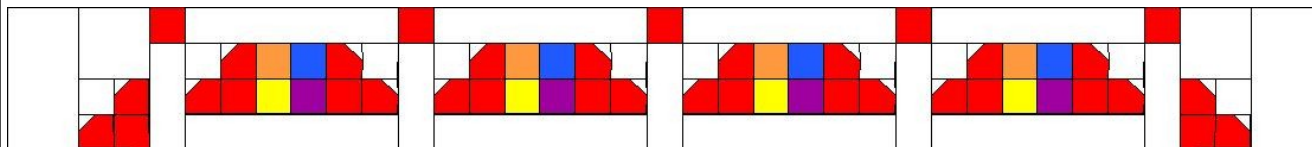
Baby Quilt – Make (2) Press to the white sashing strips.



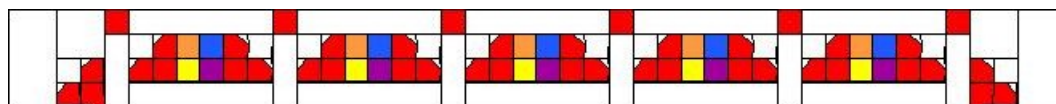
Comfort Quilt – Make (2) Press to the white sashing strips.



Twin Quilt – Make (2) Press to the white sashing strips.

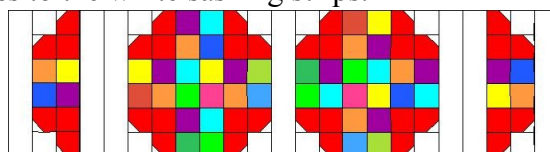


Sashing for Full Quilt – Make (2) Press to the white sashing strips.

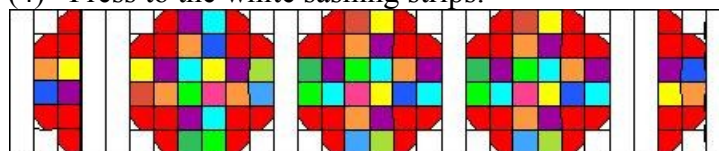


**Block Rows – 2.5” by 12.5” white rectangle between each block. Border Blocks at either end.**

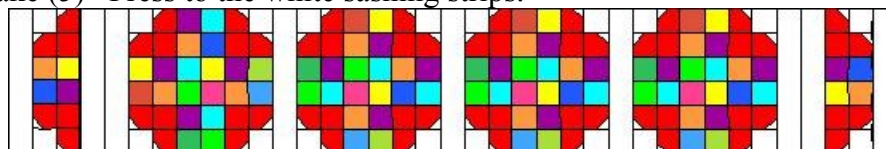
Baby Quilt – Make (2) Press to the white sashing strips.



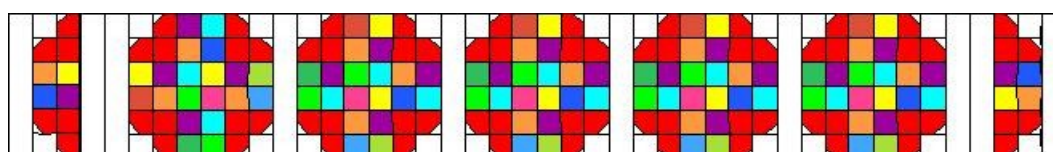
Comfort Quilt – Make (4) Press to the white sashing strips.



Twin Quilt – Make (5) Press to the white sashing strips.

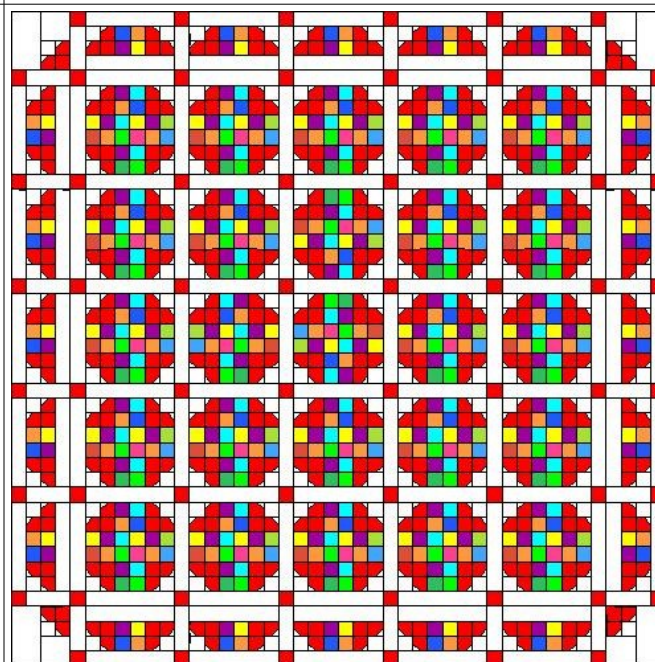
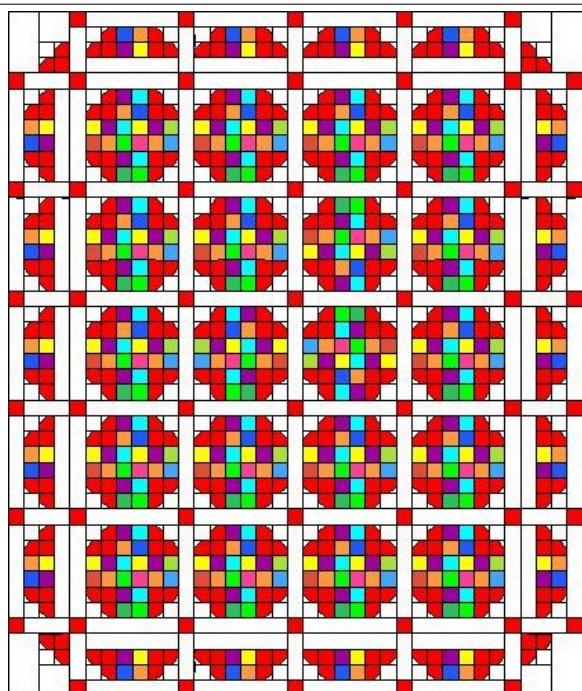
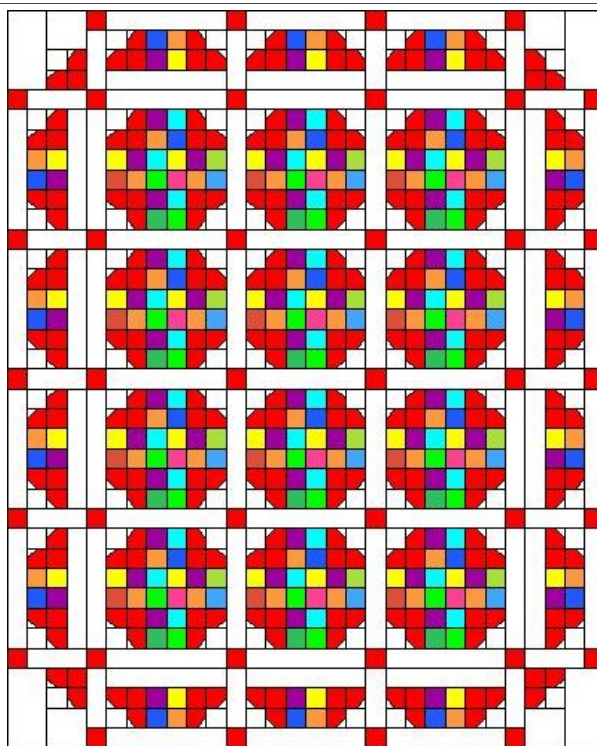
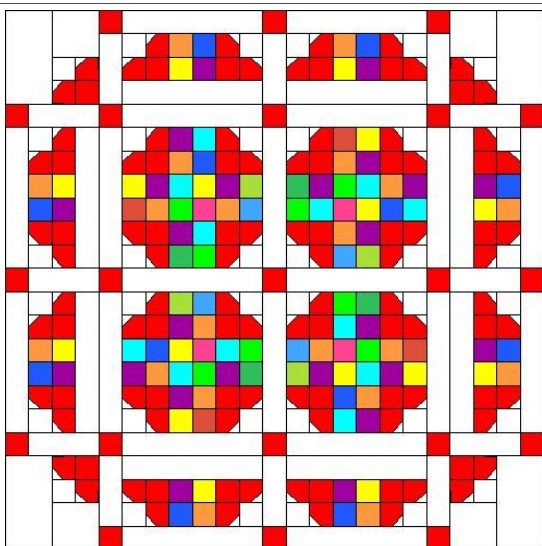


Full Quilt – Make (5) Press to the white sashing strips.
