

Sweetheart Mystery Quilt

Two Color Quilt - Clue 1

Pressing NOTE: Applicable to all clues.

Press... meaning lift iron up and press down. Do not move iron back and forth.

Clue 1

1. Gather your (1) light colored 13" square and (1) dark colored 13" square

Draw a diagonal line through the BACK of the light square.

Put both squares right sides together.

Sew a 1/4" seam on either side of the diagonal line.

Cut in half on the diagonal line.

Square up to 12.5" square.

Press one seam to the light fabric and one seam to the dark fabric.

(2) Half Square Triangle Units each measure 12.5" by 12.5".


Set aside for use later.

TIP: Making the Diagonal Line.

First press the 13" light square in half diagonally. Wrong sides of the fabric together.

Then use a ruler and draw a cutting line on the diagonal pressed line on the wrong side of the fabric.

Then use your ruler and draw two sewing lines $\frac{1}{4}$ " lightly on either side of the diagonal line.
