

Sweetheart Mystery Quilt

Option A - the Two Color Quilt

Pressing NOTE: Applicable to all clues.

Press... meaning lift iron up and press down. Do not move iron back and forth.

1. Gather up your (4) 6.5" half square triangles from Clue 2.

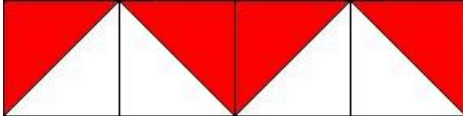
Sew together according to the diagram.

Alternate the press to the dark and press to the light half square triangles so you can nest seams.

Start with pressed to the light half square triangles on the left, then alternate.

Press the (3) seams joining the HSTs to the **RIGHT**.

(1) Unit measures 6.5" by 24.5".

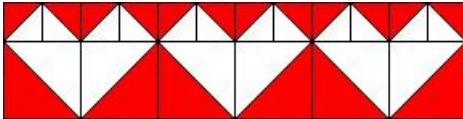


2. Sew three hearts from Clue 3 together according to diagram.

The heart with the seam pressed **UP** goes in the middle.

Nest seams. Finger press seams joining the hearts to the **LEFT**. Then press with iron.

Unit measures 6.5" by 24.5".



3. Gather up your (2) 12.5" half square triangles from Clue 1.

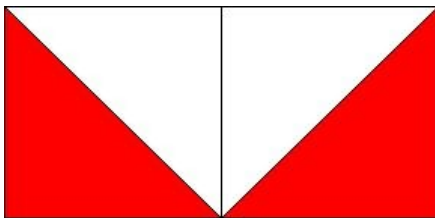
Sew together according to the diagram. Nest seams.

Press seams joining the hsts to the **LEFT**.

You will have (1).

Note: the light fabric is on the center seam.

(1) Unit measures 12.5" by 24.5".

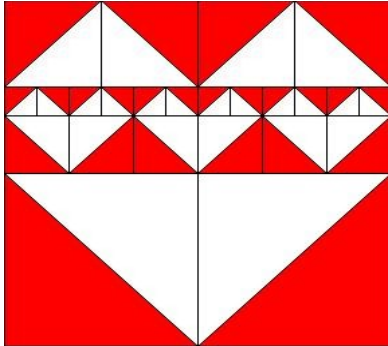


Clue 4 continued

4. Sew these three units together according to diagram.

Finger press seams to the TOP and BOTTOM (away from the three heart unit). Then press with iron.

Unit measures 24.5" by 24.5".
