(1) 6.5” by WOF strip	(6) 6.5” squares
(3) 6.5” by WOF strips	(60) 2” by 6.5” rectangles
(3) 3.5” by WOF strips	(36) 3.5” squares
(2) 2.5” by WOF strips	(24) 2.5” squares




(1) 6.5” by WOF strip	(6) 6.5” squares
(1) 6.5” by WOF strips	(21) 2” by 6.5” rectangles
(2) 2” by WOF strips	(42) 2” squares
(1) 2” by WOF strip	(3) 2” by 6.5” rectangles and (7) 2” squares
(3) 3.5” by WOF strips	(36) 3.5” squares
(2) 2.5” by WOF strips	(30) 2.5” squares

2.5” squares	24	30	Use in 9-Patch blocks (make 6)

(18) 4-Patch blocks using the 3.5” squares		AND	(6) 9-Patch blocks using the 2.5” squares

(7) 2.5” by WOF strips	(108) 2.5” squares – Changed 10/1/2014




(9) 2.5” by WOF strips	(135) 2.5” squares – Changed 10/1/2014

2.5” squares	108	135	Use in 9-Patch blocks (make 27) <i>Modified 10/1/2014</i>

(36) 4-Patch blocks using the 3.5” squares		AND	(27) 9-Patch blocks using the 2.5” squares

(4) 6.5” by WOF strips	(22) 6.5” squares and (2) 3.5” squares
(11) 6.5” by WOF strips	(220) 2” by 6.5” rectangles
(7) 3.5” by WOF strips	(84) 3.5” squares
(9) 2.5” by WOF strips	(132) 2.5” squares – Changed 10/1/2014

Full or Queen Quilt




(4) 6.5” by WOF strips	(22) 6.5” squares and (2) 3.5” squares and (2) 2” by 6.5” rectangles
(2) 6.5” by WOF strips	(42) 2” by 6.5” rectangles
(7) 2” by WOF strips	(144) 2” squares
(7) 3.5” by WOF strips	(84) 3.5” squares
(11) 2.5” by WOF strips	(165) 2.5” squares – Changed 10/1/2014

Full or Queen Quilt

3.5” squares	88	88	Use in 4-Patch blocks (make 44) Modified 10/1/2014
2.5” squares	132	165	Use in 4-Patch blocks (make 33) Modified 10/1/2014

(44) 4-Patch blocks using the 3.5” squares		AND	(33) 9-Patch blocks using the 2.5” squares
