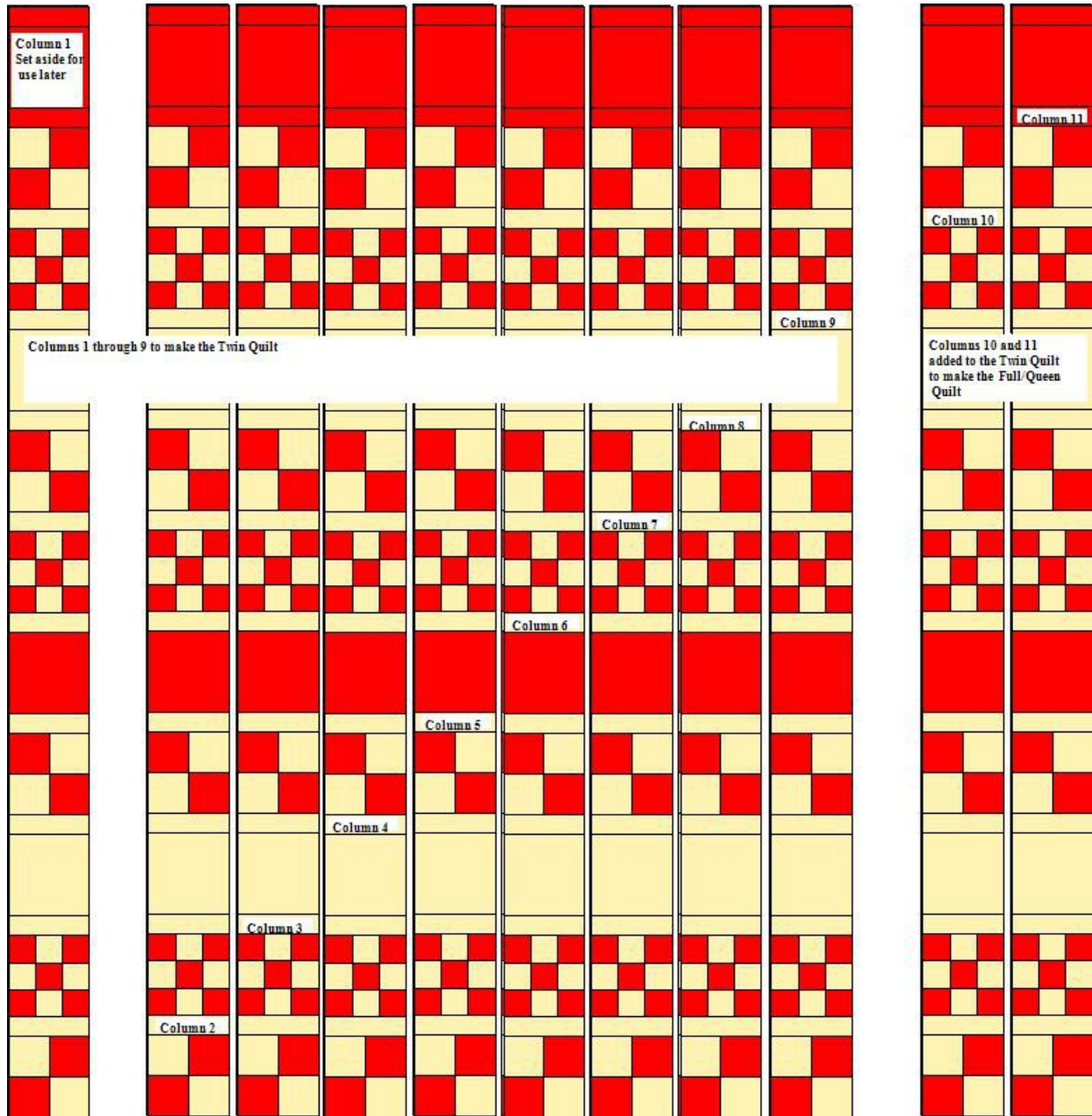

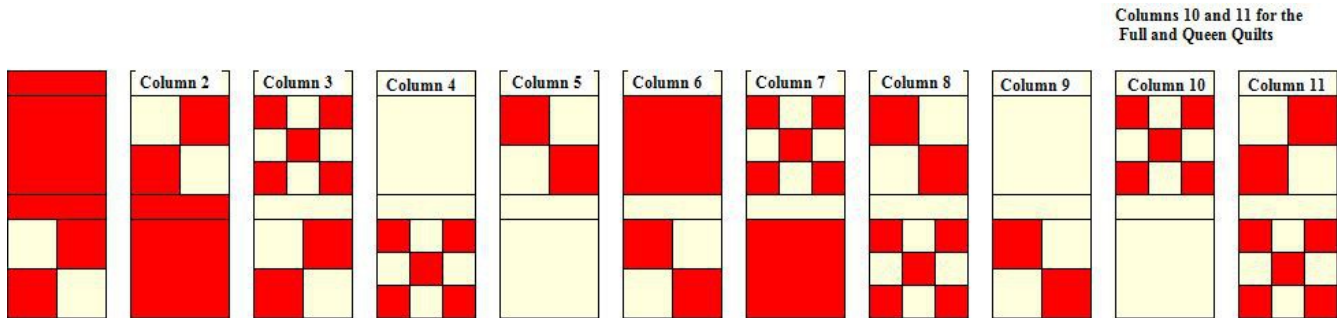
## Twin and Full/Queen Quilts

- Press all seams toward the rectangles in each column.
- Lay columns side by side, Verify that they are all identical.
- Number your columns.
  - Make small paper labels: 1 through 9 for the Twin Quilt.
  - Make small paper labels: 1 through 11 for the Full/Queen Quilt.
- Pin the number in the rectangles according to the diagram above.
- Set Column 1 aside.

**DO NOT REMOVE THE PINNED NUMBERS UNTIL THE END OF THE MYSTERY.**

## Twin Quilt - Columns 2 through 9 and Full/Queen Quilt – Columns 2 through 11:

- Sew the end of each column (right sides together) to the beginning of the SAME column to make a circle.
- After sewing, turn the circle so the right side of the fabric is facing out.
- Rotate each circle so that the column number is at the top as shown.
- Unsew the seam that is above the Column Number (above the rectangle that has the column number pinned to it.)



Your columns should look like mine in the picture below.

Columns 1 through 9 make up the Twin quilt.

Columns 1 through 11 make up the Full and Queen quilts.
