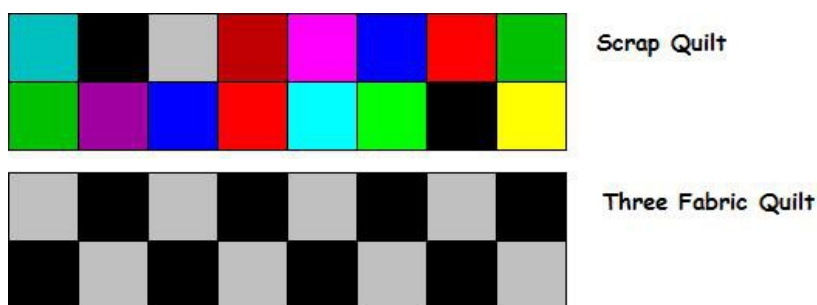


2015 Fall Mystery
All Day Sunday November 1
Pre-Mystery Sewing
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Sewing Information:

When I was sewing my mystery quilt I discovered that this task was a little more time consuming than I had first assumed.

You will be sewing the 2" squares together into
2 square by 8 square rectangles. (16 squares per unit)



1. Sew all 2" squares into pairs.

Scrap Quilt - My only rule was to not sew two of the same color together.

Three Fabric Quilt – You are making a check pattern.

2. I used chain piecing to make my units.

I made a Comfort quilt so I had 31.

I counted out 31 pairs and sewed another pair to the end of each.

I repeated this process until each unit had 8 pairs.

I finger pressed each pair before sewing.

An iron will distort the fabric.

3. Use an iron to press finished units.

Seams joining the pairs can be sewn in either direction.

Units required:

Baby/Lap - 24

Comfort - 31

Twin – 49

Full - 60
