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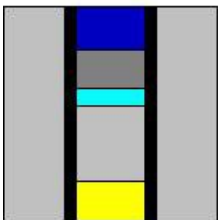
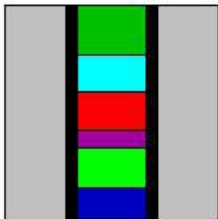
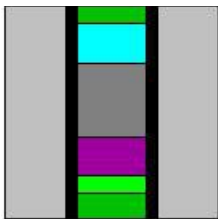

Creating Liberated Blocks

12 for the Small Quilt

24 for the Larger Quilt

1. Cut each of your panels from Clue #3 into (3) 14 inch squares





2. Make two piles of blocks. Pile #1 and Pile #2

For the Small Quilt – 6 blocks in each pile

For the Larger Quilt – 12 blocks in each pile

Put a variety of blocks from each of the sizes into each pile.

**3. Draw around each block and trim using scissors.
Do one pile at a time.**

c. Using a scissors cut on the drawn lines in each block.		c. Using a scissors cut on the drawn lines in each block.
