2 sizes:

Baby/Lap Quilt: 48" by 60"

Twin/Comfort Quilt: 60" by 84"

We will be cutting the panels.

This will happen during the mystery.

1. STARCH Your Fabric

Press ALL your fabric using STARCH. I used a medium amount of starch.
A light starching may not be enough to stabilize the fabric.

Starch your liberated panels, accent fabric and background fabric.
The most important for heavier starch is the background fabric.

2. TRIM your accent fabric and background fabric

WOF = Width of Fabric. Usually 42" to 45". Varies by fabric.

1. Your fabric measures 42" (including selvages). Don't trim. Leave selvages on the fabric.

OR

2. Your fabric measures larger than 42" Trim one side of the fabric so that it measures 42".

3. CUT your Accent Fabric

Baby/Lap Quilt.

Cut (8) 1.25" by 42" rectangles

Comfort/Twin Quilt

Cut (16) 1.25" by 42" rectangles

4. CUT your Background Fabric

5 pins – straight or safety. Label 5 pieces of paper. I used sticky notes.

A, B, C, D, E

When you finish cutting each set, pin the note to the set.

Baby/Lap Quilt.

SET A: Cut (2) 5.25” by 42” rectangles

SET B: Cut (2) 4.75” by 42” rectangles

SET C: Cut (2) 4.25” by 42” rectangles

SET D: Cut (2) 3.75” by 42” rectangles

SET E: Cut (5) 6.5” by 42” rectangles

Comfort/Twin Quilt

SET A: Cut (4) 5.25” by 42” rectangles

SET B: Cut (4) 4.75” by 42” rectangles

SET C: Cut (4) 4.25” by 42” rectangles

SET D: Cut (4) 3.75” by 42” rectangles

SET E. Cut (7) 6.5” by 42” rectangles
