All Day Saturday February 18, 2017**

**Clue #1**

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**Baby Quilt – 44” by 44”  
Comfort Quilt – 56” by 68”**

**All seam allowances ¼ “.**

**Step 1:**

**Construct 9-patch blocks.**

**Baby Quilt – Make 9**

**Comfort Quilt – Make 20**

**Block measures 6.5” by 6.5” unfinished**

**For each block use**

**(4) black 2.5” squares**

**(4) background fabric 2.5” squares**

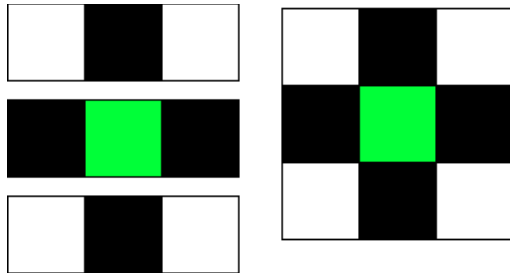
**(1) accent fabric 2.5” square**

**Sew (3) rows as illustrated.**

**Press to the black squares.**

**Sew rows together.**

**Press in either direction.**



**Step 2:**

**Baby Quilt – Make 36 (4) in each color**

**Comfort Quilt – Make 80 (4) in each color**

**For each unit use**

**(1) 3.5” by 4” colored rectangle**

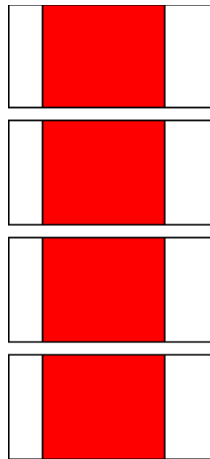
**(1) 3.5” by 1.5” background fabric rectangle**

**(1) 3.5” by 2” background fabric rectangle**

**Sew unit together as illustrated.**

**Unit measures 3.5” by 6.5” unfinished.**

**Press to the background fabric.**



# 2017 Solid Colors Mystery Clue #2

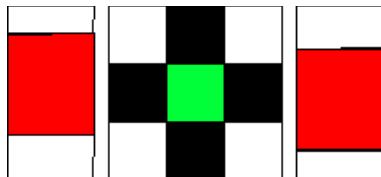

Sew (1) from Step #1 and (2) from Step #2:

Left Side: Skinny background fabric is on top.

Right Side: Skinny background fabric is on the bottom

Press to the outside units.

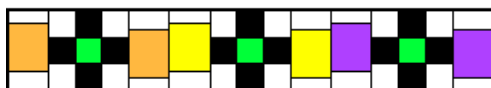


Arrange your units so that you like the positions of the colors.  
Sew the rows together as illustrated.

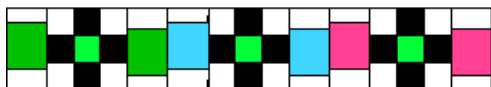
Press seams to the right.

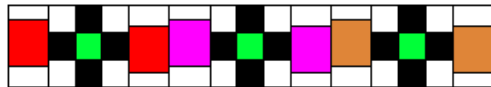

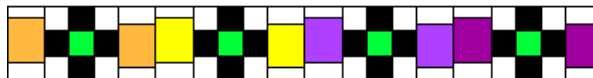

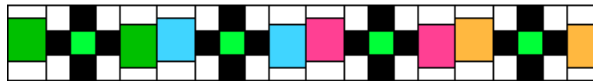


## Comfort Quilt – Rows 2, 4, 6, 8 and 10




### Clue #3

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**Completing the Quilt Top . Odd numbered rows.. finish and sew to adjoining rows before going to next row. Even numbered rows were completed in Step 2.**

<p>Row 1</p>	<p><b>Background Fabric</b>                  . 3.5” square on each end                  . 3.5” by 6.5” rectangles                  (2) for Baby and (3) for Comfort  <b>Comfort</b>                  . Units from Step 2                  that match row 2  <b>Skinny strips on the RIGHT</b></p>	<p>Match colors with row below                  Press to the left</p> 
<p>Row 2</p>	<p><b>From Clue #2</b></p>	<p>Match colors with rows above and below</p> 
<p>Rows 3 and 5                  Baby Quilt</p> <p>Rows 3, 5, 7, 9                  Comfort Quilt</p>	<p><b>Background Fabric – 3.5” by 6.5”</b>                  One for each end</p> <p><b>Accent Fabric 6.5” squares</b>                  (2) for Baby and (3) for Comfort</p> <p><b>Skinny strips on top to the LEFT                  on bottom to the RIGHT</b></p>	<p>Match colors with rows above and below. Press to the left.</p> 
<p>Rows 4 and 6                  Baby Quilt</p> <p>Rows 4, 6, 8, 10                  Comfort Quilt</p>	<p><b>From Clue #2</b></p>	<p>Match colors with rows above and below.</p> 

**Continue this pattern until you finish  
Row 6 of the Baby Quilt  
or Row 10 of the Comfort Quilt.**

**LAST ROW**

**Background Fabric**

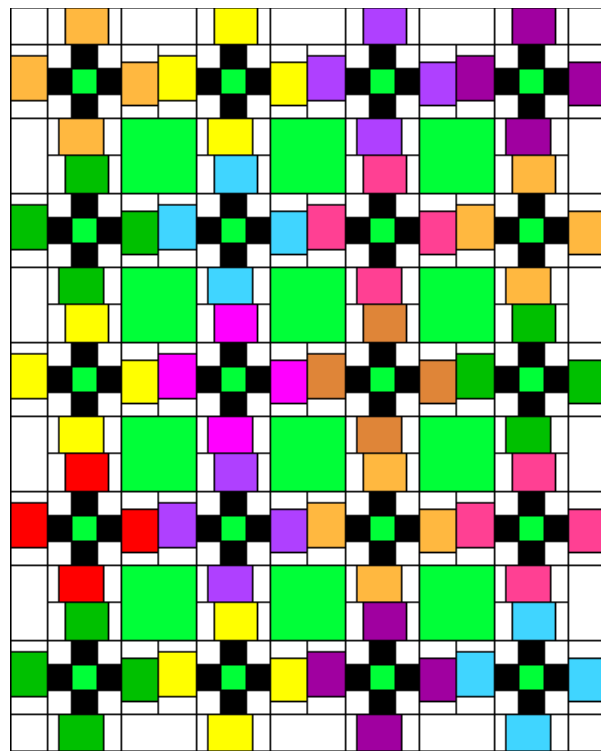
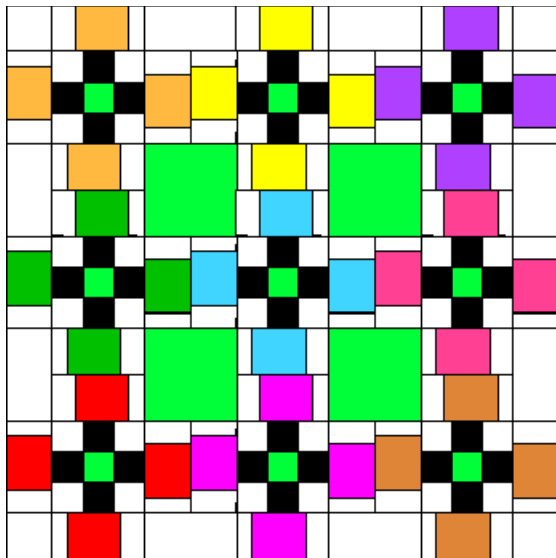
- . 3.5" square on each end
- . 3.5" by 6.5" rectangles  
(2) for Baby and (3) for Comfort
- . Units from Step 2  
that match row 2

**Skippy strips on the LEFT**

Match colors with row ABOVE  
Press to the left

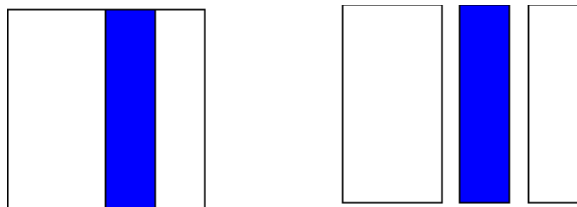

Clue #4**

**Borders**



**Baby – (36) blocks – 4.5” unfinished**

**Comfort – (54) blocks – 4.5” unfinished**

**(4) 4.5” squares of accent fabric for the corners.**

<b>Baby Quilt</b>	<b>Comfort Quilt</b>
<b>Background Fabric</b> <b>(36) 4.5” by 1.5” rectangles</b> <b>(36) 4.5” by 2.5” rectangles</b>	<b>Background Fabric</b> <b>(54) 4.5” by 1.5” rectangles</b> <b>(54) 4.5” by 2.5” rectangles</b>
<b>Colored Fabrics</b> <b>(36) 4.5” by 1.5” rectangles</b>	<b>Colored Fabrics</b> <b>(54) 4.5” by 1.5” rectangles</b>
<b>Create (4) piles of the colored fabrics</b> <b>Each pile has nine different colors</b>	<b>.Create (2) piles of colored fabrics with (12) fabrics in each pile</b> <b>This is for the (TOP and BOTTOM borders)</b> <b>.Create (2) piles with (15) fabrics in each pile. (SIDE borders)</b>

**Sew your block as illustrated above.**

**Press to the colored fabric.**

Join the blocks to make your borders. See diagram below.  
Sew two of the borders to two sides of your quilt.

Add the accent squares to the **TOP and BOTTOM** borders and sew them to your quilt.  
Press toward the borders.
